

Recycling Centers



The Tri-County Solid Waste Office and Le Sueur, Nicollet and Sibley Counties support the operation of three Recycling Centers. These Recycling Centers accept recyclables from all residents, businesses and haulers throughout the Tri-County area. Residents are encouraged to use their own community's recycling program and also to visit any of the following Recycling Centers.

Nicollet County/North Mankato Recycling Center

Hours: Weekdays 10 am to 5 pm, Sat. 8 am to 3 pm, Sun. 11 am to 3 pm. Materials accepted: Newspaper, cardboard, glass food and beverage containers, tin & aluminum cans, #1 & #2 plastic bottles, office paper, magazines and textiles. These items are accepted free of charge.

Hands Inc. - Winthrop (507) 647-5387

Hours: Tuesdays 8 am to 12 noon, Wednesdays 12 noon to 4 pm and Fridays 8 am to 12 noon. Materials accepted: Glass bottles, #1 & #2 plastic jugs, aluminum and tin cans, newspaper and corrugated cardboard. These materials are accepted free of charge.

Waste Management Recycling Center

Hours: Weekdays 8 am to 5 pm, Sat. 9 am to 12 noon. Materials accepted: Newspaper, cardboard, glass food and beverage containers, tin & aluminum cans, #1 & #2 plastic bottles, office paper, magazines and textiles. These items are accepted free of charge.

For a small fee both the Nicollet County/North Mankato Recycling Center and the Waste Management Recycling Center will accept tires, appliances and car batteries. Call the Recycling Centers for current charges on these items.

Rural Recycling Drop-Offs

Two satellite drop-off locations are located in rural Nicollet County.



The first site is located in Klössner at the County Highway Garage. The second site is located at the coop in Norseland. These two sites accept recyclables every Saturday from 8 am to 12 noon. Residents throughout the Tri-County area of Le Sueur, Nicollet and Sibley Counties are welcome to use the satellite locations. Materials accepted:
